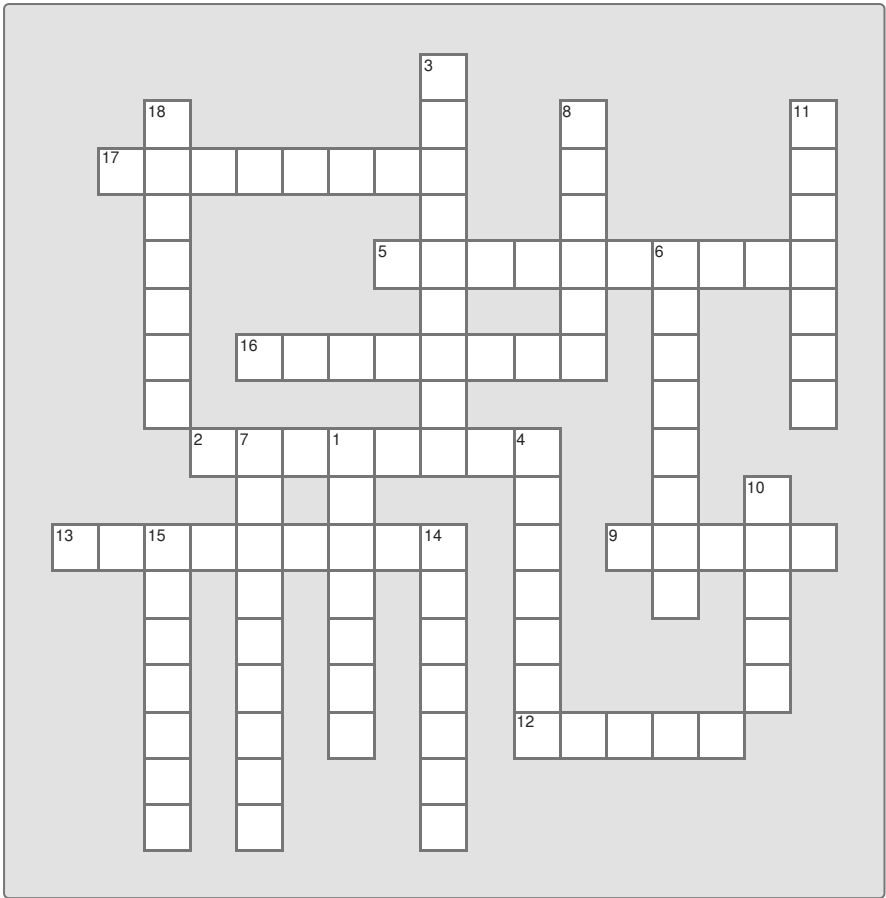

- 12 A type of consonant that is produced with the velum lowered, allowing air to escape through the nose.
- 13 A complex vowel sound that transitions from one vowel quality to another.
- 16 A type of consonant that is produced by the lungs.
- 17 A type of consonant that is produced with both lips.

- 1 A speech sound that is capable of differentiating meaning.
- 3 A speech sound that represents a single phoneme.
- 4 The omission of a sound or syllable in speech.
- 6 A type of consonant that is produced by closing the glottis and creating a build-up of air pressure in the vocal tract.
- 7 A type of consonant that is produced with the tongue curled back.
- 8 A dialect or accent that pronounces the r sound in all positions.
- 10 A type of consonant that is produced by creating a suction in the mouth.
- 11 A type of consonant that is produced by completely blocking the airflow and then releasing it.
